- According to the Code of Canon Law, "As far as possible the
  person to be confirmed is to have a sponsor. The sponsor's
  function is to take care that the person confirmed behaves as a
  true witness of Christ and faithfully fulfils the duties inherent in
  this sacrament." That implies that sponsors live close enough to
  the candidates to be involved in their lives, attend a sponsor
  meeting and come to at least some classes with the candidate.
- The Diocese of Richmond requires all sponsors to be in compliance with the criteria set forth in canon law and listed below
- Canon 874.1 To be admitted to undertake the office of sponsor, a person must:
- 1. Be appointed by the candidate for Baptism, or by the parents or whoever stands in their place, or failing these, by the parish priest or the minister; to be appointed the person must be suitable for this role and have the intention of fulfilling it;
- 2. Be not less than sixteen years of age, unless a different age has been stipulated by the diocesan bishop, or unless the parish priest or the minister considers that there is a just reason for an exception to be made;
- 3. Be a Catholic who has been confirmed and has received the blessed Eucharist, and who lives a life of faith which befits the role to be undertaken;
- 4. Not labor under a canonical penalty, whether imposed or declared;
- 5. Not be either the father or the mother of the person to be baptized.
- 874.2 A baptized person who belongs to a non-Catholic ecclesial community may be admitted only in company with a Catholic sponsor, and then simply as a witness.
- 893.2 It is desirable that the sponsor chosen be the one who undertook this role at Baptism.
