Sacrament of Baptism (Infant) – Please contact the parish office to make arrangements. Requirements: Families must be registered and participating in the Parish for at least 3 months before attending the required preparation class. Expectant parents are encouraged to attend class before the birth of their child.

Sacrament of First Penance & Eucharist – First Sacraments are celebrated in the 3rd Grade. Families must be registered and participating in the Parish; children must be enrolled in parish Religious Education or attend private Catholic school. Previous year's attendance in a religious education program is required.

Sacrament of Confirmation – Youth may celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation in their sophomore year of high school. Families must be registered and participating in the Parish; youth must be enrolled in parish Religious Education or attend private Catholic school. Current year's attendance in a religious education program is required.

Sacrament of Matrimony – At least one of the parties must be registered and participating in the Parish for at least 3 months prior to contacting the Parish priest to begin pre-marital preparation. You must plan to begin pre-marital preparation 6 months prior to your proposed wedding date.

R.C.I.A. (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) – For those who are seeking God and choose to enter a journey of faith and conversion leading to initiation into the Roman Catholic Church. Please contact the parish office.

Anointing/Hospital Visit – If admitted to a hospital or confined at home, please call the parish office to arrange for a visit, communion and/or Anointing of the Sick. The Sacrament of Anointing is celebrated the last Sunday of each month at 9:45 A

Financial Corner

Did you know?... Every registered family receives by mail a set of envelopes (at a cost to the parish). This process helps us know when families move as the post office notifies the envelope company of any address changes. They then notify us. In addition, each family receives a subscription to *The Catholic Virginian*, our Diocesan newspaper. The parish pays for this service by returning to the Diocese 1.35% of every dollar received through the offertory. Your assistance in keeping us posted on address changes, etc. is very important.

We go through the parish rolls annually and place families in an inactive status if we have received nothing from them in a year. It is our presumption that they have chosen to belong and participate in another community if there is no support on the parish level. We just recently moved 72 families to an inactive status. However, 5 of these families registered children for Religious Ed and, therefore, were added back to the roles. In these difficult economic times, if you cannot donate, please write on an envelope that you are still prayerfully with us, and kindly let us know if we can help in any way.

What does it mean to be an "Active Catholic?" Frequently, those seeking to celebrate Marriage, have their children baptized, or serve as sponsors for Confirmation or Baptism request a letter stating that they are parishioners. To receive such a letter, one must be registered in the parish, attend Mass regularly, and be committed to stewardship of time, talent and treasure. In any parish community, one means of verifying participation is through the use of parish offertory envelopes. If you choose not to participate in the support of the parish, or are unable to contribute at this time, please at least note your prayerful support on your envelope and place it in the weekly offertory. We will then be aware of your continued participation, and you will not be noted as "inactive" on our parish roster.
